

# SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBCONTRACTORS

## IMPORTANT NOTE

The following items are required prior to mobilization. No checks will be issued until the following items are submitted and approved.

**Please reference your company's name and the jobsite name (and/or number) on all documents. Each jobsite must have its own set of documents.**

Per the Subcontract Agreement with RA-LIN, and the Safety Manual incorporated into the Subcontract per Schedule G, any subcontractor on-site performing work is required to have the following:

- Person on-site trained in CPR and First Aid
- Competent Person Training as Related to Trade
- Person on-site with 10-Hour OSHA Card
- Safety Data Sheet (SDS) Books covering any and all chemicals brought to jobsite.
- **Site Specific** Safety Plan

Depending on the Subcontractor's scope of work, the following items may be required:

- Forklift Certification (if equipment being used)
- Boom & Scissor Lift Certification (if equipment being used)
- Fall Protection Certification (Competent Person)
- Any subcontractor disturbing dirt on the jobsite should have an NPDES Level 1A White Card (at a minimum). Georgia Soil and Water Conservation Commission (GSWCC) will issue the certification card.
- Scaffolding Safety Certification
- Crane Operating Card
- Report of Annual Inspection of Crane
- Welding Certificate
- Rigging Certificate
- Any other Certifications that may apply to Subcontractor's scope of work.

Each subcontractor is responsible for ensuring RA-LIN has a digital copy and a hard copy of each of the above items submitted. Submit these items to Brian Oden (at the RA-LIN Corporate Office, 101 Parkwood Circle, Carrollton, GA 30117).

Please review the above listing with the Site Superintendent to verify what is and is not on record at the jobsite. Those items which have not been turned in yet need to be obtained and submitted immediately. If the subcontractor is missing any items, please contact Brian Oden to discuss scope specific variances.
